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Letters in Name (upper-case)

Prior to assessment, teacher prints child's first name using all upper-case letters in the space below.

Point to each letter in child's name (not in order) and say, "Tell me the name of this letter." Place a check above the letters that the child correctly names. Underline the letters that the child does not name.

If child is not able to say the letter correctly, have her point to the letter that you say (out of order). Include in notes that child has receptive knowledge.



Examples:

A child who correctly names the first letter of her name would look like this: M A R Y

A child who could name some letters in her name would look like this: M A $\underline{R} \underline{Y}$

A child who could not name any letters in her name would look like this: MARY

When child is able to name all upper-case letters in name, point to each lower-case letter in child's name (not in order) and say, "Tell me the name of this letter." Place a check above the letters that the child correctly names. Underline the letters that the child does not name.

Letters in Name (lower-case)

Prior to assessment, teacher prints child's name using upper-case for 1st letter and lower-case for other letters.
