## **Phoneme Deletion**

K-3 Phonological Awareness, Activity Guide 7

Level: Word Syllable Phoneme

Objective: Help students identify phonemes (sounds) within words, delete a single phoneme, and say the remaining word or sounds.

#### **Important Note**

• This advanced skill is especially challenging because students are using only auditory information with no written context. Students may need additional modeling and practice to master this skill.

#### **Steps**

- 1. Teacher says the word and asks students to repeat it.
- 2. Teacher **asks** students to say the word without a specific phoneme (sound).
- 3. Example:
  - Teacher: "Say cash."
  - Students: "Cash."
  - Teacher: "Now say cash without the /k/ sound."
  - Students: "Ash."

#### Tip

Use the gradual release method:

I Do: Model what you want them to do.

We Do: Do it together so they can practice.

You Do: Ask them to complete the task on their own.

### **Suggested Practice Words**

I Do (,	'The word is Without the sound, it sounds like'')
1.	Past without /t/ (pas)
2.	Hand without /h/ (and)
We Do	o ("Let's all say Now let's say it without the sound:"
3.	Plain without /n/
4.	Spite without /t/
5.	Mist without /m/
You Do (Say Now say without the sound.")	

- 6. Tend without /t/
- 7. Crash without /r/
- 8. Stop without /s/
- 9. Spill without /s/
- 10. Frame without /r/
- 11. Play without /l/
- 12. Trim without /r/

What next? Once they can delete individual phonemes, students are ready for the advanced task of phoneme substitution. Next time, try PA Activity Guide 8: Phoneme Substitution.
